

Become a Belfast Street Pastor!



Please read carefully!

We're delighted you want to become a Street Pastor. Sorry there's a wee bit of paperwork, but we're sure you'll understand! ***Please complete the forms now*** so we have the paperwork completed as training begins. *The best way is to bring all the forms together to one of the training days complete with ID.* Don't worry about the photo – we can take one of you on the day – it's just for our own use.

You can apply to become a Street Pastor, if you:

- Are a **committed Christian** with a heart for others
- Are at least **18** years old (no upper limit)
- Have been committed to a **local church** for at least a year and get a positive **reference** from one of the leaders
- Are willing to do some **training**
- Can commit to going out **once a month** (you can do more if you are able!)

If you can answer yes to these points, complete these forms and bring/send them to us.

2) Reference Form Ask your church leader to complete, and either give back to you to give to us (best), or s/he can scan and email it to us, or send by post.

3) Confidential Self-disclosure form – complete and return to us

4) AccessNI

Access NI has changed from 1 Apr 2015. There is now an online part and a paper form (above) which should be quicker and help avoid errors. From now on each person has to

- Receive or Download the form for full details
- Go on line (a relative or friend can help you)
- Create a user ID and password
- Enter the PIN number for Belfast Street Pastors (in the form above)
- Fill in the on-line form with all your details
- Note the 10-digit reference number and enter it in the form you have printed
- Take the form with your 3 pieces of acceptable ID to someone on the Street Pastors management committee and then Street Pastors will process your Access NI check.
