Enfield Street Pastors. Are you interested?

A Street Pastor is a member of a local church who has chosen to respond positively to the night time problems of a town. Working as a team we engage with people on the streets by caring, listening and directing them towards essential services, as well as providing a reassuring presence for people who might feel nervous or anxious, particularly those who are vulnerable and have perhaps dropped through the net. Street Pastors are volunteers.

On Patrol

Currently, Enfield Street Pastors are patrolling the Fore Street corridor, Enfield Town, Palmers Green and Southgate.

We have helped vulnerable people get home late at night. We have been to Communities in shock after a fatal stabbing, and brought reassurance to the people we meet. We have advised young teenagers to go home to their parents. We have talked to many people. In particular, we have given positive hope to young people who realise they need to sort their lives out; and when asked to 'give a reason for the hope within us', we have shared the Good News of the Gospel with people and prayed with people.

Street Pastors is an incredible opportunity to take your Christian faith on to the streets to a community that welcomes your presence and is happy to engage with you.

Enfield Street Pastors. Yes I'm interested

If you are interested in becoming involved with Enfield Street Pastors, here is what is needed to keep us on the road. We need...

1: More Prayer

Prayer is vital to the work of Enfield Street Pastors. Before any team goes on patrol they have a time of prayer together. We need Prayer Partners because prayer makes such a difference - prayer changes things in people's lives and communities!

We need people who will meet to pray while a team is on patrol. We need people to back specific pastors in prayer. We need people with an email address who will receive the team reports and pray for the people contacted.

Please consider giving some time to praying for us and being a vital part of what we're doing.

2: More Pastors

We always need more Street Pastors.

Anyone who is a committed Christian, a member of a local church, and who is endorsed by the leadership of that church, can become a Street Pastor. You need to be over 18 (no upper age limit), and able to commit to an 8 session training course in two groups of four Saturdays spread over three months, and to one patrol a month on the streets, working in a team.

The course includes subjects such as roles and responsibilities, knowing your community, drugs and alcohol awareness, youth culture, listening skills, and others. You may be surprised to learn that the average Street Pastor is a 50 year old lady. The training begins in March or September each year.

Please pray about being a part of taking the church onto the streets and training as a pastor.

3: More Pounds

Any organisation needs finance and Enfield Street Pastors is no exception. We give away many helpful items to people we meet. Things like flip flops to girls who find their high heels are causing problems. Items that help protect young ladies in particular from having their drink tampered with. Items of helpful literature about safe transport, keeping safe, as well as Christian literature, including the Street Pastor NIV. Then there's the uniform which cost £100.

All these need finance, plus office costs, and for those extra items like First Aid training and keeping the kits supplied.

Many people around the UK have become '1 in a 100' and are giving £10 a month to their local Street Pastors. You can use the standing order form to help us this way if you wish.
