



GSP good news & significant interventions May/June 2017

Saturday 6th May – Quietish night but good conversations with a group from Exeter up for the rugby who asked for directions a then gave a donation and also 2 ladies at Café Rene. 2 pairs of flip flops given out. 27 bottles/glass cleared away.

Saturday 13th May – Very wet evening, pretty quiet. We were called to Fever to assist a female who was very drunk. The police were called as she was uncooperative to us. 2 pairs of flip flops given out. 23 bottles/glass cleared away.

Saturday 20th May – Chatted to homeless street people. Greeted lots of people on the way to the docks. 2 very drunk men were helped, sobered up and got on feet. One fixed up with a taxi, the other met a friend. 5 pairs of flip flops and 8 bottles of water given out. 27 bottles/glass cleared away.

Saturday 27th May – CCTV called us to a gentleman who was drunk at the bottom of Westgate Street. We walked him back to his flat. He gave us a donation. Walked a young woman with major problems to Worcester Street. She then ran away and the police were notified.

Sunday 28th May – Met a man who was concerned for his ex who had major mental health problems. We met her on Barton Street and advised her to return to hospital. We bought her some food. Believed to be the same woman found by the team out the previous night. Called paramedic then ambulance to a young man lying outside BHS. He was unresponsive. He was with a friend who said he was very drunk. 3 pairs of flip flops, 5 bottles of water, 3 ponchos and 2 space blankets given out. 34 bottles/glass cleared away.

Saturday 3rd June – Helped a girl who had fallen in the street. 2 pairs of flip flops and 4 bottles of water given out. 16 bottles/glass cleared away. Several good conversations and several compliments tonight.

Saturday 10th June – several chats and thanks for doing a good job. The street was very rowdy. There were a number of drunk men & women. Several of these refused help. 2 pairs of flip flops and 3 bottles of water given out. 30 bottles/glass cleared away.

Saturday 17th June – Young woman outside Fever was drunk but no assistance needed as the ambulance had already been called. Lots of positive comments and compliments, a good positive atmosphere. 7 pairs of flip flops and 6 bottles of water given out. 33 bottles/glass cleared away.

Email sent 18th June – “Just to say a big thank you to the team of street pastors who gave my sister-in-law a pair of flip flops tonight. She was walking barefoot through town after taking off her new futuristic boots to walk back to her hotel when the team gave her some flip flops Such a kind gesture. Thank you very much!”

Saturday 24th June – Police called us to attend to a drunk young man. His girlfriend came to pick him up. An ambulance was called to a woman who was not responding. Lots of compliments tonight. 3 pairs of flip flops and 11 bottles of water given out. 25 bottles/glass cleared away.

Friday 30th June – Supported a young woman who was drunk and being sick. Stayed with her for 1 ¼ hours. 26 pairs of flip flops and 8 bottles of water given out. 35 bottles/glass cleared away as well as a space blanket.
