

GSP good news & significant interventions Jan/Feb 2018

Saturday 6th **January** – We attended an unconscious male. A young woman had called an ambulance; we covered him with a foil blanket and waited until the ambulance came. We informed CCTV about was a brawl outside a closed nightclub. We went to assist a casualty there but he disappeared.

Saturday 13th January – We saw several incidents. The police were in attendance outside Fever. A man on the pavement outside a night club was taken off an ambulance. 4 bottles of water were given out and 12 bottles/glass cleared away. Many compliments

Saturday 20th January – The police asked us to assist a girl found collapsed outside GL1. They called a paramedic and she was taken to A&E. CCTV asked us to help a drunk male outside Registry. We assisted him to a taxi rank. He asked for help getting home and the police agreed to take him. 4 pairs of flip flops and 2 bottles of water were given out and 23 bottles/glass cleared away. 2 safety blankets were given out too.

Friday 26th January – We helped a man who was unwell. His phone battery was dead so we called his girlfriend who came to help. We helped another man who was drunk and couldn't stand up. We took him to a cash machine to get some money for a taxi. then found a taxi to take him home. We called the police to deal with a disturbance and waited until the police arrived. We kept an eye on 2 couples having a disagreement. We assisted a young man who was drunk. We gave him water and stayed with him until he was able to stand and walk. 5 pair of flip flops and 12 bottles of water were given out and 24 bottles/glass cleared away.

Saturday 27th January – We gave support and help to several young people who were drunk. There were plenty of high fives tonight. No police on the street. 19 pairs of flip flops and 7 bottles of water were given out and 15 bottles/glass cleared away.

Saturday 3rd February – We came across several people incapacitated by drink and being helped by a friend. There we lots of compliments. 5 pairs of flip flops and 14 bottles of water were given out and 20 bottles/glass cleared away.

Saturday 10th February – A very cold and windy night. Good spirits on the streets with no major problems. Brunswick Road was closed. 1 pair of flip flops and 8 bottles of water were given out and 7 bottles/glass cleared away.

Saturday 17th February – Talked with someone who was suicidal. Talked and prayed and got them to speak with the Samaritans but to no effect. Called CCTV and the person headed off whilst we were doing so. CCTV followed them for a while and they were seen heading out of town. 4 pairs of flip flops and 6 bottles of water were given out and 17 bottles/glass cleared away.

Friday 23rd February – A very quiet night. Not many people about. 5 bottles of water were given out and 14 bottles/glass cleared away.

Saturday 24th February – A very cold night. We came across 2 girls outside the regal. The police were in attendance. One was lying on the pavement being sick. The other became incapacitated and her boyfriend came to fetch them. 4 pairs of flip flops and 7 bottles of water were given out and 9 bottles/glass cleared away.
