



GSP good news & significant interventions Nov/Dec 2018

Saturday 3rd November – A young female had a black eye from her brother. She wanted to talk to the police which we arranged. CCTV asked us to attend to a young female outside 'A Plan' who felt sick. A young male outside Salvation Army needed help to phone home for a lift. We stayed with him until the lift arrived. We chatted with a young female we had helped previously. 5 pairs of flip flops and 8 bottles of water were given out. 28 bottles/glass cleared away.

Saturday 10th November – We attended a young drunk female outside TGIF who was vomiting. She was with a friend. She recovered and we ordered a taxi. We helped the police with a drunken man. An unconscious man was found being circled by young cyclists. We got him up and phoned his father to collect him. One young man asked us to pray for him. 5 pairs of flip flops and 8 bottles of water were given out. 15 bottles/glass cleared away.

Saturday 17th November – we attended a distressed drunk young woman from Stroud who had no money for a taxi. She eventually contacted someone to give her a lift. Lots of people showed respect for what we do. 3 pairs of flip flops and 3 bottles of water were given out. 18 bottles/glass cleared away.

Saturday 24th November – We had several conversations. We escorted separately 3 girls who were on their own. A very quiet night. 1 pair of flip flops and 1 bottle of water were given out. 19 bottles/glass cleared away.

Friday 30th November – Lots of general conversation but otherwise a quiet night. There were some antisocial incidents but these were well dealt with by door staff & police. 5 bottles of water were given out. 20 bottles/glass cleared away.

Saturday 1st December – the streets were fairly busy and happy. Not a lot of trouble. Numerous punters said what respect they have for Street pastors. 7 pairs of flip flops and 9 bottles of water were given out. 25 bottles/glass cleared away.

Saturday 8th December – the team kept an eye on a young lady struggling on her feet as she walked home to Nettleton Road. There were lots of compliments. 10 pairs of flip flops and 7 bottles of water were given out. 21 bottles/glass cleared away.

Saturday 15th December – A couple were very distressed outside a nightclub and reported they had evicted from the building. They stated that they and some friends had been abused. The police arrived shortly afterwards. It was fairly busy on the streets and lots of arguments. Lots of thanks for what we do. 13 bottles of water were given out and 32 bottles/glass cleared away.

Friday 21st December – busy on the streets with a large police presence. Some bad behaviour but no serious trouble. Spoke to several homeless people who were concerned about Christmas. Lots of affirmations. 6 pairs of flip flops and 6 bottles of water were given out. 45 bottles/glass cleared away.

Saturday 22nd December – Assisted a girl with suspected concussion. The paramedic was called and we attended until the ambulance arrived. 3 pairs of flip flops and 8 bottles of water were given out. 44 bottles/glass cleared away.

Monday 31st December (New Years Eve) – we accompanied a disorientated young man from the Cross to Boots where he was met by friends from ATIK. It was very busy with folks migrating between venues, but lots of opportunities to chat about what we do and why we do it. 8 pairs of flip flops and 11 bottles of water were given out. 51 bottles/glass cleared away.
