



## **GSP good news & significant interventions May/June 2019**

**Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> May** – Chatted to a young man at the Cavern. Reported missing a young woman who had last been seen at night coming from the Regal. A fairly quiet night. 1 pair flip flops and 10 bottles of water given out. 25 bottles/glass cleared up.

**Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> May** – A fairly quiet night, good atmosphere but some aggression on the streets. Good conversations. 5 pairs of flip flops and 8 bottles of water given out. 32 bottles/glass cleared up.

**Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> May** – Busy with punters. There was a spot of trouble at Fever but the police sorted it out. Spoke to several people at the Cavern. Gave a sleeping bag to a homeless young man. 5 pairs of flip flops and 9 bottles of water given out. 20 bottles/glass cleared up.

**Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> May** – Prayed with a young man with a difficult home situation and needing mental health support. New club – Encore, called us to help with a man who was unconscious and fitting. We waited with him whilst an ambulance came. A couple of compliments and lots of thanks for flip flops. 8 pair of flip flops given out. 28 bottles/glass cleared up.

**Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> June** – There was a reasonable atmosphere with many folk on the streets. The peak time was at the end of the Liverpool/Spurs match when people exited the venues. 5 pairs of flip flops and 7 bottles of water given out. 30 bottles/glass cleared up.

**Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> June** – We helped a lady who had a broken hand from a previous incident with an ex-boyfriend. We escorted a young lady to a friend's car. There was lots of appreciation. 9 pairs of flip flops given out. 35 bottles/glass cleared up.

**Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> June** – A busy night. Lots of referrals from CCTV but no major incidents. Lots of positive comments and compliments. 4 pairs of flip flops and 7 bottles of water given out. Also 2 safety blankets. 27 bottles/glass cleared up.

**Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> June** – Assisted a very drunk man who was passed out, contacted his family and stayed with him until they arrived. In the last hour we gave out lots of flip flops and received lots of compliments. There was lots of aggression and 2 serious fights outside Encore. 20 pairs of flip flops and 2 bottles of water given out. 30 bottles/glass cleared up.

**Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> June** – CCTV alerted us to a gentleman asleep outside the bus station. 2 lads were involved in a fight. We were able to calm them down and encourage them to move on. 20 pairs of flip flops and 15 bottles of water given out. 35 bottles/glass cleared up.
