



## **GSP good news & significant interventions Mar-Dec 2020**

**Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> March** – There was a friendly atmosphere again and usual chats of appreciation. We were joined by 2 students from University of Gloucester who were filming for a new promotional video. 3 pairs of flip flops and 1 bottle of water were given out. 35 bottles or broken glass were cleared up.

**Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> March** – A fairly quiet night. We kept an eye on an aggressive man having a go at one of the street homeless. There were plenty of compliments and thankyou's. The manager of Butlers said they were expecting to be closed the following week due to the Covid 19 crisis. There were no Street Medics out. 6 pairs of flip flops and 5 bottles of water were given out. 32 bottles or broken glass were cleared up.

**Patrols cancelled from March 21<sup>st</sup> until 22nd August due to the COVID 19 pandemic**

**Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> August** – We received some compliments about work of Street Pastors in Cheltenham & Bristol. A mobile phone was found and given to the police. One man had a very large bump on his head. We were asked to go to The Doctors to assist. 32 bottles or broken glass were cleared up. No drinks or flip flops given out because of restrictions.

**Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> September** – A very quiet night. Fever and Butlers were both closed due to COVID19. Some compliments from passers-by. 14 bottles or broken glass were cleared up. No drinks or flip flops given out because of restrictions.

**Saturday 31<sup>st</sup> October** – Streets quiet. We received friendly greetings everywhere we patrolled. We helped one very drunken girl to her feet. A friend was called by phone and we helped her to the car. 10 bottles or broken glass were cleared up. 2 pairs of flip flops and 3 bottles of water were given out.

**Patrols were again cancelled during Lockdown 2 in November.**

**Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> December** – A very quiet night. We greeted lots of people. 1 bottle cleared up. No drinks or flip flops given out.

**Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> September** – Streets were very quiet. There were conversations with door staff of Butlers & Regal and some compliments from passers-by. 5 bottles or broken glass were cleared up. No drinks or flip flops given out.

**A patrol was planned for New Year's Eve but this was cancelled as Gloucester went into level 4 restrictions**
