



GSP good news & significant interventions Mar – Apr 2022

Saturday 5th March – A young girl thanked us for helping her the previous week. We helped a man find the street where he lived. We were called by CCTV to a young man at GL1 and phoned his mum so she could pick him up. He was displaying very erratic behaviour; He was later reunited with his girlfriend. We also assisted a young man to GL1 to meet his Nan who came to pick him up. He was very drunk and his nan thanked us for phoning and waiting with him. 5 pairs of flip flops and 6 bottles of water given out and 33 bottles/broken glass were cleared up.

Saturday 19th March – A girl with 2 lads had medical problems. We called the paramedics (street medics) Lads arranged a lift and looked after her. 2 pairs of flip flops and 6 bottles of water given out and 35 bottles/broken glass were cleared up.

Saturday 26th March – A few brief chats about being appreciated. We looked for opportunities to bless but offers sometimes refused. Received a donation after chatting to a man about what we do. 1 pair of flip flops and 1 bottle of water given out and 67 bottles/broken glass were cleared up.

Saturday 2nd April – Chatted with a couple of girls struggling with mental health issues. Worked with night patrol to keep the girls safe and find friends to take them home. We received lots of compliments. 1 safety blanket, 4 pairs of flip flops and 6 bottles of water given out and 11 bottles/broken glass were cleared up.

Saturday 23rd April – Helped a man who had collapsed. He had a medical condition but had not taken medication and had been drinking. Called medics and together we accompanied him to get a taxi. We escorted a couple of single girls to requested destinations. It was a busy night with a number of events taking place. 9 pairs of flip flops and 7 bottles of water given out and 34 bottles/broken glass were cleared up.

Saturday 30th April – Assisted a woman who had slipped and cut her head. We stayed with her & her family whilst police came and finally Street Medics. We waited with her 2 teenage children until a family member arrived to take them home. We chatted to a guy with learning difficulties who was very inebriated. He was upset about the death of his father. 1 pair of flip flops and 2 bottles of water given out and 57 bottles/broken glass were cleared up.
