



GSP good news & significant interventions July – Aug 2022

Saturday 2nd July – We helped young woman who was being pestered by 2 young men. We provided a safety blanket to a young man who was being looked after by the City Marshalls. 8 pairs of flip flops, 6 bottles of water and 1 safety blanket given out and 54 bottles/broken glass were cleared up.

Saturday 16th July – The team witnessed a serious assault and called the Street medics, police and ambulance. We left the injured man in the care of the Street Medics. We stayed with a young man who was very drunk. He eventually got up and headed off home. 2 pairs of flip flops and 12 bottles of water given out and 23 bottles/broken glass were cleared up.

Saturday 30th July – We offered to help a girl in distress outside ATIK but were not needed. We intended to call Street Medics but found that ATIK had already called them. We chatted to several people about the work of Street Pastors. We were thanked by a dog owner for sweeping up broken glass as it was a hazard to her dog. 2 pairs of flip flops, 2 bottles of water and 1 safety blanket given out and 47 bottles/broken glass were cleared up.

Saturday 6th August – There was a generally good natured and appreciative crowd out tonight. It was less busy than the previous week but we had several compliments. We chatted to a young man about the work of Street Pastors. 4 pairs of flip flops and 22 bottles of water given out and 28 bottles/broken glass were cleared up.

Saturday 13th August – A very hot evening. We helped a young man who had been assaulted and had an injured ankle. We walked him back to the YMCA building. We walked a gentleman to the taxi rank. We had a good chat with a man who was thinking about self-harming. It was a peaceful evening with a good atmosphere. One man filmed us handing out flip flops to a woman. 12 pairs of flip flops and 20 bottles of water given out and 38 bottles/broken glass were cleared up.

Saturday 27th August – A very quiet night. 7 bottles of water and 1 safety blanket given out and 24 bottles/broken glass were cleared up.
