



## **GSP good news & significant interventions November – December 2022**

**Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> November** – We helped a young man get to his parents – he was in a bad way on the floor. We helped a young woman find her friends. We spoke to a lady in a wheelchair and signposted her to Gloucester City Mission. We helped a man who was being sick. 5 pairs of flip flops, 7 bottles of water and 2 safety blankets given out and 22 bottles/broken glass were cleared up.

**Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> November** – a very quiet night. There was a strong police presence on Eastgate Street and it was a calm atmosphere .1 bottle of water given out and 48 bottles/broken glass were cleared up.

**Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> November** – one of the team was taken unwell with back pain and needed attention from the medics. Had a couple chats with people interested in what we do. 1 bottle of water and 2 safety blankets given out and 6 bottles/broken glass were cleared up.

**Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> December** – another quiet night. We signposted someone to the Cathedral to get breakfast. 4 pairs of flip flops, 3 bottles of water and 3 safety blankets given out and 35 bottles/broken glass were cleared up.

**Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> December** – We looked out for a person who had been reported missing to the police. We prayed for a couple of people who had shared their situations with us. We observed a situation which was eventually resolved without our intervention. 1 bottle of water given out and 26 bottles/broken glass were cleared up.

**Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> December**– We helped a young lady to a taxi – her mother had already been called by the nightclub. We helped a young woman and her boyfriend to a taxi. We gave flip flops to a young woman who was then able to walk to the Quays. We handed in a lost bank card to the police. We had several compliments and lots of 'Happy Christmas'. 6 pairs of flip flops and 2 bottles of water given out and 21 bottles/broken glass were cleared up.

**Saturday 31<sup>st</sup> December (New Years Eve)** – We had a radio call to ATIK. There was a drunken man on the ground. The street medics were in attendance. We helped to get him up and walk him to get a lift to a local hotel. 1 pair of flip flops, 2 bottles of water and 3 safety blanket given out and 38 bottles/broken glass were cleared up.
