



GSP good news & significant interventions January – March 2023

Saturday 14th January – A young man was grateful to the team, he wanted to be independent getting home but his mobile was flat. We left him walking home. Lots of hugs tonight. 6 pairs of flip flops, 8 bottles of water and 2 safety blankets given out and 35 bottles/broken glass were cleared up.

Saturday 28th January – Spoke to someone who has housing needs. Lots of compliments and thanks for flip flops. We helped to calm an aggressive pair of young men. We helped a young woman who was having an asthma attack. 6 pairs of flip flops and 6 bottles of water given out and 19 bottles/broken glass were cleared up.

Saturday 11th February – We helped one very drunk girl. We left her with 3 friends who sent her home. We chatted with several street folk. Chatted with a man about his family situation and said we would pray. 7 pairs of flip flops and 5 safety blankets given out and 18 bottles/broken glass were cleared up.

Saturday 25th February – We helped a young man get home. We helped a girl who said her drink had been spiked, to get a lift home with her boyfriend's mum. We helped a young man to find his friends in the nightclub. We had several compliments. 6 safety blankets, 1 sleeping bag and 4 bottles of water given out and 46 bottles/broken glass were cleared up.

Saturday 4th March – We listened to and signposted one guy who was recently homeless. We listened to and comforted a young woman who had recently broken up with her boyfriend. 1 pair of flip flops, 2 safety blankets and 3 bottles of water given out and 46 bottles/broken glass were cleared up.

Saturday 11th March – Talked to lady who was sleeping in a tent by the library. She said was safe and at home. We took two ladies to get taxis. We were complimented and CCTV camera operators were very happy to know we were patrolling. 1 pair of flip flops and 1 bottle of water given out and 25 bottles/broken glass were cleared up.

Saturday 25th March – We gave a space blanket to a young lady who was unconscious after too much to drink. Several people complimented us. 1 safety blanket and 8 bottles of water given out and 34 bottles/broken glass were cleared up.
