

Rules of Leamington Spa Street Pastors

Version 1 7th May 2014

These Rules have been agreed by the Trustees acting under Section 69 of Leamington Spa Street Pastors Constitution.

(this Constitution is the model prescribed for Street Pastor initiatives by the Ascension Trust as at the date of our formation in January 2013)

These Rules should be read in conjunction with the Constitution (available on the website) and most have been adopted so as to clarify certain aspects of how the Constitution should work in practical terms.

Members

People must apply to become members; do not have to be Christians, but must 'recognise and support the essential Christian nature of the charity' (line to be added to membership application form). Partner organisations to be encouraged to nominate members.

Existing Street Pastors and Prayer Pastors are members; on commissioning, Street Pastors become members because they have already requested to join, agreed to the Core Values and have been accepted by the Trustees.

SP's continue as members if they step down as SP's.

(Agreed 7th May 2014)

Trustees (members of the Management Committee)

The requirement (section 31) to propose appointments 'prior' to an Annual General Meeting shall be taken to mean 48 hours before the start of the Meeting.

In the same way as Street Pastors, Trustees must be practicing Christians and, unless they are formally Church Leaders, must be supported by a positive reference from their Church Leader.
