First aid		Young man collapsed outside Middletons - intoxicated. We stayed in attendance until the ambulance arrived 1.5 hours after us. The young man appeared to be fitting so we kept a close eye on his condition. He was being harassed by a woman who said she was a paramedic- she was verbally abusive to the young man and so we created a shield of protection around him and encouraged the woman to move on. He was picked up by the ambulance and taken to St John's Ambulance where he assaulted a paramedic- he did return and apologise.
