Street Pastors return to the streets of Newcastle

Since 12th April 2021 Street Pastors have been on the streets every Saturday night. With the easing of Covid restrictions, restaurant's & pubs were able to open up for the first time since October 2020, with outside seating only. We were asked by Northumbria Police if we would like to start



patrols again. Our answer was YES.

July 2021 saw the removal of almost all restrictions in England. Thousands of people returned, enjoying meals, drinks and music. The city's' night economy is once again booming back to 2019 levels. Theatres, cinemas, casinos, restaurants, pubs & night clubs are once again are seeing numbers increasing every week. Our work load has risen significantly, with the need to help people who become vulnerable through drink or drugs. They quite often become separated from their friends or become disorientated in a strange city.

For example one weekend in September, we helped eight vulnerable people. We helped the police with a unconscious young person while the ambulance was called; we organised a guy to be picked by his wife at 1am; we helped a family, who were not drunk, find their parked car; we assisted the police with a young

person who had mental health issues and would only accept help from females; as well as giving out 14 pairs of flip flops and as many bottles of water. It was a long shift for the team from 10:30pm until 4:30am.

"Protecting the Vulnerable Award" from Northumbria Police

In July 2021, we were honoured & excited to receive the *Protecting the Vulnerable Award* at the first Northumbria Police *Citizens in Policing awards*. It is a huge thank you from Northumbria Police to our volunteers who give their time and energy to serving the people of Newcastle's night time economy - caring, listening and helping. Working alongside door staff, medical staff & Northumbria Police ensuring all who are out enjoying themselves are looked after if they become vul-



nerable. The past year has been a huge challenge for so many of us. The work of Street Pastors continues only restricted by the lockdowns.
