She was an amazing artist and ceramicist and produced banners for our scheme for the Advent and Christmas Banner displays at St Mary's Totnes for several years.

If you go into the Chapel of St Laurence in St Mary's (on the left as you look up towards the altar) hanging there here is her very first Street Pastor banner on silk and it serves as reminder of this remarkable and wonderful lady.
