## Online Networker - Job Description

Wantage and Grove Street Pastors work within Wantage and Grove and the surrounding villages. We are seeking to appoint a part-time Online Networker. The worker will focus on creating content that promotes our core messages of Listening, Caring and Helping by Street Pastors online, primarily using Social Media. Working for 3 hours per week for a 1-year contract starting in November 2022.

- We are looking for a motivated individual who is able to develop and be creative in an online space that will impact those in the community of Wantage, Grove and surrounding villages.
- Initially home based: working across the wider Wantage area including the neighbouring villages.
- Accountable to the Coordinator and to the Board of Trustees

### Key Duties

- 1) Research what is already being done by other street pastors and charities and write a communications strategy document for the rest of the year.
- 2) Open up new Platforms on Social Media alongside our Facebook Profile on Instagram and Tik Tok. Increasing our following on all platforms reaching people mainly in the local area. Targets for each to be set at the beginning of the Job.
- 3) Create content on our messages of Listening, Caring and Helping (which may include relevant Christian content).
- 4) To be a key link between Street Pastors on the street and to people online.
- 5) Reviewing and updating our website, working and in agreement with the Area Co-ordinator.
- 6) Observing Safeguarding Policies at all times and creating a safe way for Wantage and Grove Street Pastors Networking Online.
- 7) To attend line management meetings and Trustee meetings when appropriate and submit reports of work to the Trustees.
- 8) To record and track the work being carried out which will enable repeat work across the UK.
- 9) Work with other street pastors to help promote the above and support the work of Wantage & Grove Street Pastors.
- 10) To attend training that is necessary for the role.
