He had had an argument with his other half and was expecting to spend the night in his car! We suggested other options but he seemed content to sleep in his car. It was fairly warm evening, so we weren't too worried about him.

One of our teams visited Sweatbox Youth Centre and spent time chatting with the young people and staff. The same night we cleared up a lot of broken glass in

the Undercroft Car Park – our kit bag includes a dustpan and brush for this very reason.

Another night in Wantage town centre, we found that some of the plants in one of the Wantage planters had been uprooted, perhaps by a frustrated reveller.

Before heading home for the night, one of our Street Pastors replanted the plants.
